Athlete Support Programme

Post entry mechanism for elite and high performance athletes Athlete-led development programme – financial assistance (may include an offer of a fee waiver) and a network of athlete-led support services. Does not include any special reductions in entry criteria or the offer of a place at DIT.

Elite Athlete Academic Entry Scheme

Pre-entry mechanism for elite sportspeople – additional CAO points for entry to full-time undergraduate courses up to a maximum of 10% or 45 CAO points. Limited number of places for those that have achieved a very high level of sporting performance.

The Benefits of each 'package of support' is assessed on an individual basis and ranks support depending on:

- The Athlete's sporting achievements
- Potential to develop as an athlete
- Commitment to represent and promote the Institute in specific sport(s)

- Achieve a high level of sporting performance, demonstrate an ability to compete at Interprovincial, National or International
- Commit to represent the Institute in the appropriate competitive pathway
