- ▲ Manage the ESB Coaching Team to deliver the Coaching Plan
- ▲ Coach our National Senior Squad
- Some coaching and oversight of ESB's more junior squads to optimize their development.
- Provide hands-on management and oversight of ESB's Learn to Swim Program, including staff rostering, supervision of teachers and the promotion of high quality technique and skills to ensure the development of young swimmers and their progression to ESB's competitive squads.
- ▲ Be a positive role model, creating an encouraging and motivating swim environment
- Have an in depth understanding of child safeguarding requirements and best safeguarding practices



- Evaluate sessions and give constructive feedback to coaches and swimmers and promote internal workshops to improve teachers' and coaches' skills.
